

### **EVENT OVERVIEW**

- A free public parade with approximately 5,000 participants from all over the world.
- Estimated 350,000 spectators (throughout the day) with a peak of approximately 150,000.
- 20x ticketed grandstands along the route offering 2,500 seats.
- Broadcast live in London, the USA and around the world
- Organised by Destination Events.
- Run successfully for 38 years!

- 5,000 overseas participants
- 30,000 bed nights in London hotels
- Estimated total spend with GVA multiplier £32,480,000 PA

#### INFORMATION FOR BUSINESSES & RESIDENTS

- LNYDP is a large scale public event requiring installation of infrastructure. Some roads will be closed prior to, during and immediately after the event. These closures will be minimised to reduce disruption.
- Access for emergency services and statutory works will be maintained.
- There are no pedestrian restrictions and access to your home or place of work will not be impeded.
- There will be a large number of people coming into the area to enjoy the parade. If you are travelling on New Year's Day, please plan your journey and leave additional time for travel. If you are travelling via public transport, please check the TFL website before setting off.
- The audience are primarily families with children, so we are expecting a positive celebratory atmosphere and welcome residents to come along and enjoy the show with us. There's plenty to see and it's a great experience!
- We would expect businesses, especially those selling food and drinks, to be busy and would recommend planning ahead to make the most of the event.



18:30	Phased re-opening of roads as removals completed



# EVENT MAPS:PARTICIPANTS DISPERSAL ROUTES





## **ROAD CLOSURES 03:30 – 18:30 – 1st JANUARY 2024**

#### Parade Assembly & Event Infrastructure Street Closures

Berkeley Square / Piccadilly / St James's St & Pall Mall

Piccadilly eastbound including the underpass, Hyde Park Corner on-slip and all side roads to Berkeley Street

Piccadilly westbound including the bus lane from Regent Street, St James's Street and Arlington Street

Berkeley Square including all access roads onto the square, plus advance warnings to Park Lane, Curzon Street, South Audley Street and Grosvenor Square

#### **Event Infrastructure Street Closures**

Whitehall / Parliament Street

Whitehall (from Horse Guards Avenue to Parliament Square) / Parliament Street / Horse Guards Avenue (westbound only from Victoria Embankment)

Whitehall (Trafalgar Square to Horse Guards Avenue) / Great Scotland Yard

#### **Event Parade Dispersal Street Closures**

Parliament Square / Victoria Street / Millbank

Storey's Gate, Tothill Street, St Margaret's Street, Abingdon Street, Millbank

Bridge Street / Victoria Embankment
